Residency Duration

CHOK MAA Artist Residency lasts between 3 and 5 weeks per application. The specific dates are proposed by the artist and depend on available scheduling.

Studio & Accommodation

The residency is housed within a four-level shophouse in Khlong San, Bangkok.

The building includes:

- Two exhibition floors with integrated accommodation
- A dedicated studio floor with art-making facilities and a balcony
- A rooftop outdoor space

Artists are responsible for their own:

- Flights
- Meals
- Local transport
- Art materials
- Personal and day-to-day living expenses throughout the residency

Residency Support

A Residency Manager is available on **Fridays and Saturdays** to assist with practical matters, including:

- Studio and facilities questions
- Neighbourhood orientation
- Supplier recommendations
- Exhibition logistics

For urgent matters outside these hours, an emergency contact number will be provided.

Check-in Meetings

An introductory meeting will be scheduled at the beginning of your residency to discuss your project, working rhythms, and any specific requirements for the space. Depending on the development of your work, we may also arrange a mid-residency conversation. This is intended as an informal curatorial exchange rather than a formal review, and will be shaped by what is most useful to your practice.



Closing Exhibition

At the conclusion of your residency, you may be invited to present work within the residency exhibition space.

The presentation is intentionally flexible and may take the form of:

- A single new work
- A focused selection of works produced during the residency
- A process-based or durational presentation
- Another format developed in conversation with the residency team

We are happy to discuss the exhibition with you in the weeks leading up to its installation.

Exhibition Documentation:

The residency will professionally document the exhibition, including installation photography. Digital copies of this documentation will be provided for your records, grant acquittals, portfolio use, and future applications.

Sales

Should works be offered for sale during the exhibition, all sales will be managed through CHALK HORSE Gallery.

Freight

Artists are responsible for arranging and covering the cost of freight to and from the residency.

Documentation & Promotion

During your residency, we may photograph your studio, artwork, and exhibition for documentation and promotional purposes.

These images may be shared through the residency's Instagram, website, and other communication channels. Please let us know if there are any works you would prefer not to be documented prior to the exhibition.

Residency Archive

In the spirit of reciprocity, artists are warmly invited to contribute a small work made during the residency to the CHOK MAA Residency Archive. The archive is non-commercial and exists as a growing record of the artists who have participated in the program.
